



Rm A201 | led by Katy Law | Book: \$7 (9 wk study)



Rm A204 | led by Leah DiPascal | Book: \$8 (9 wk study)



EXODUS

Exodus could be considered the central book in the Old Testament because it records the departure of God's people from Egypt—His act of saving the Israelites and establishing them as a covenant community, a nation chosen to serve and represent Him. God also offered the nation forgiveness of their sins through blood sacrifice; gave them guiding principles for daily life; protected them from certain death in the Red Sea; and declared that He longed to draw near to them and establish a permanent, intimate relationship. There will be a strong concentration on the theological importance.
